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Dear Lacerne,

Thank you for sending the new label and product sheet for the Calmoseptine jars. The label and flyer are very nice.

We have been using Calmoseptine ointment in several clinical areas here at Memorial Medical Center (MMC). As you know, MMC is a 1000 bed medical and teaching hospital that has a varied patient population. Calmoseptine has a multi purpose use in service patient care areas.

Pediatrics:

1. Calmoseptine is used on the buttock of children with skin irritaion related to urine and stool.
2. Skin breakdown related to chemotherapy/ immunosuppression (in this application we use stomahesive powder over the cream to create a non stick, dry surface).

Medical Unit:

1. Used for perineal irritation related to urine, stool, or any other drainage.
2. Has application around irritation caused from leakage around gastrostomy/feeding tubes.

Oncology:

1. The cream is used on irritated or denuded skin related to skin breakdown common in the immunosuppressed, poorly nourished patient.
